



# WISCONSIN BIATHLON CUP RACE #3

## SUNDAY, February 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2014

Wisconsin Biathlon Cup Race #3 will be hosted by Blackhawk Ski Club in Middleton, Wisconsin

### INTRODUCTION:

WI Biathlon Cup Series race #3 will take place on February 2nd, 2014 at Blackhawk Ski Club in Middleton, Wisconsin. Races will include two open events (**No novice event**).

### REGISTRATION AND ENTRY FEES:

Event registration will take place at Blackhawk Ski Club in the Jumping Chalet. Entry fees are \$10 plus USBA membership required. No awards will be given out. (\$10 race day USBA membership available at race.)

### NOVICE RACE:

**There is no novice race scheduled with this event** but two novice races are scheduled for the WI Biathlon cup events on February 15<sup>th</sup> at McMiller and March 1<sup>st</sup> at Blackhawk .

### OPEN RACE:

The open races are for biathletes with previous biathlon experience and are USBA safety certified. The race format will be mass start by groups of 10 (seeded by ability/speed). There will be 5 skiing stages (2.5K each) and 4 shooting rounds (PPSS). Youth skiing distances will be reduced. A 150 meter penalty loop is included for each missed shot. Club rifles will not be available for the open race unless pre-arranged. Biathletes with some experience and have their own rifle for the race will be permitted to participate in the open race but will not be allowed to ski with a rifle on the course.

A relay event will be held after the Open Race if there are sufficient teams interested. The relay event will consist of 2 or 4 members depending on interest. Each relay member will ski two 1 K loops with 1 round of shooting per skier between loops. For every round of shooting there will be eight bullets available, although the last three can only be single-loaded manually one at a time from spare round holders or bullets on the mat. If after eight bullets there are still misses, one penalty loop must be taken for each missed target remaining.
