







WISCONSIN BIATHLON CUP RACE #5, #6

Saturday and SUNDAY, March 1 & 2, 2014

Wisconsin Biathlon Cup Race #5 and #6 will be hosted by Blackhawk Ski Club in Middleton, Wisconsin 10118 Blackhawk Rd, Middleton, WI 53562 *ENTER EAST GATE*

REGISTRATION AND ENTRY FEES:

Event registration will take place at Blackhawk Ski Club in the Jumping Chalet. Entry fees are Novice Race \$15 plus \$10 USBA race day membership (available at race). Open Race \$15 per day plus \$10 daily USBA membership if needed.

NOVICE RACE, Saturday March 1:

Novice race will be a three 2K laps with two shooting stations (Prone, Prone) and 150 meter penalty laps. No previous biathlon experience necessary. Novice racers will not carry rifles. Instruction, biathlon rifles and ammunition will be supplied.

OPEN RACES: The open races are for biathletes that are USBA safety certified.

Saturday March 1 Sprint and Relay:

Sprint format with 10 second staggered starts (seeded by ability/speed). Three skiing stages (2.0K each), two shooting rounds (PS), 150 M penalty loop. Youth skiing distances will be reduced.

Relay race for safety certified biathletes will to follow the Novice Race. The relay event will consist of 4 members. Each relay member will ski two 1.2 K loops with 1 round of shooting per skier between loops (PPSS). For every round of shooting there will be eight bullets available, although the last three can only be single-loaded manually one at a time from spare round holders or bullets on the mat. If after eight bullets there are still misses, one penalty loop must be taken for each missed target remaining.

Sunday March 2:

Race format will be mass start by groups of 8 to 10 biathletes (seeded by ability/speed). Five skiing stages (2.5K each), four shooting rounds (PPSS), 150 M penalty loop. Youth skiing distances will be reduced.
