



# Introduction to Biathlon Clinic

Saturday December 10, 2011 • McMiller Sports Center in Eagle, WI

The Wisconsin Biathlon Association invites you to come out and learn about biathlon, the Olympic winter sport combining cross country skiing and rifle marksmanship.

**TOPICS:** The basics of biathlon shooting fundamentals will be covered. No previous experience is required. The clinic will consist of indoor presentations along with outdoor instruction and practice on the biathlon range. The clinic will take place regardless of snow conditions.

**TIME:** The clinic will begin at 11 AM.

**LOCATION:** The clinic take place at the McMiller Sports Center biathlon range. Please see the attached document about accessing the biathlon range.

**WHAT TO BRING:** All the required equipment will be supplied. Participants should plan to dress for indoor and outdoor weather.

**AGES:** The clinic is intended for ages 11 and up. Parents are welcome to accompany younger athletes.

**EQUIPMENT:** Biathlon rifles, targets, and ammunition will be supplied for use by all participants. Conditions permitting, you are welcome to bring along your ski gear, but it is not required.

**COST:** There will be a \$20 fee for all adults 16 and older. Boys and girls ages 11-16 are free. All participants will receive a safety booklet and DVD.

Access to the biathlon range is from the ski trail that begins behind the main shelter building. DO NOT use the gravel road adjacent to the novice trap range.
