



Introduction to Biathlon Clinic

Saturday December 15, 2007 • McMiller Sports Center in Eagle, WI

The Wisconsin Biathlon Association invites you to come out and learn about biathlon, the Olympic winter sport combining cross country skiing and rifle marksmanship.

TOPICS: The basics of biathlon shooting fundamentals will be covered. No previous experience is required. The clinic will consist of indoor presentations along with outdoor instruction and practice on one of the McMiller ranges.

SCHEDULE:

9:30-10:00:	Clinic Registration
10:00-11:00:	Safety Certification Presentation
11:00-12:30:	Basics of the prone shooting
12:30-1:00:	Lunch break
1:00-2:30:	Basics of the standing shooting

WHAT TO BRING: Participants should plan to dress for indoor and outdoor weather. There will be a short break between sessions, so you are encouraged to bring along a bag lunch or snack.

AGES: Due to Wisconsin state firearm laws, individuals must be ages 12 and older. Parents are welcome to accompany younger athletes.

EQUIPMENT: Biathlon rifles, targets, and ammunition will be supplied for use by all participants. Conditions permitting, you are welcome to bring along your ski gear, but it is not required.

COST: There will be a \$10 fee for all adults 18 and older. Youth ages 12-18 are free.
