



Trail Kids lead organizer, 2026-2027 season

About the program: The Madnorski Trail Kids program introduces kids ages 5-11 to the movement and fun of Nordic skiing. Sessions are 1 hour per week and focus on fundamental ski skills, games, and small pod group skis. The goal of this program is to get kids outside and having fun in the winter while learning the basic movements of Nordic skiing. The program lasts for 8 weeks, starting at the beginning of January. Sessions are typically held at Elver Park when snow conditions allow, and at CXC when natural snow conditions are poor.

About the role: The Trail Kids lead organizer will plan sessions and coordinate coaches. The lead organizer will also communicate with parents about session details, equipment requirements, and changes to plans due to weather or snow conditions. Importantly, the lead organizer will ensure a safe and encouraging environment. Madnorski has a Trail Kids curriculum available to be implemented by the lead organizer and an established group of volunteer coaches.

Ideal qualifications:

- Strong organizational and planning skills.
- Excellent communication skills with both youth and parents.
- Comfortable managing a group of volunteer coaches.
- Experience coaching youth athletes and/or teaching beginner skiers.
- Must successfully pass the US Ski & Snowboard Safesport training and background screening, with no convictions or active investigations involving harassment, abuse, or sexual misconduct.
